The College believes that certain values should guide each decision made in the operation of the College. Mid-Plains Community College values excellence in education through:

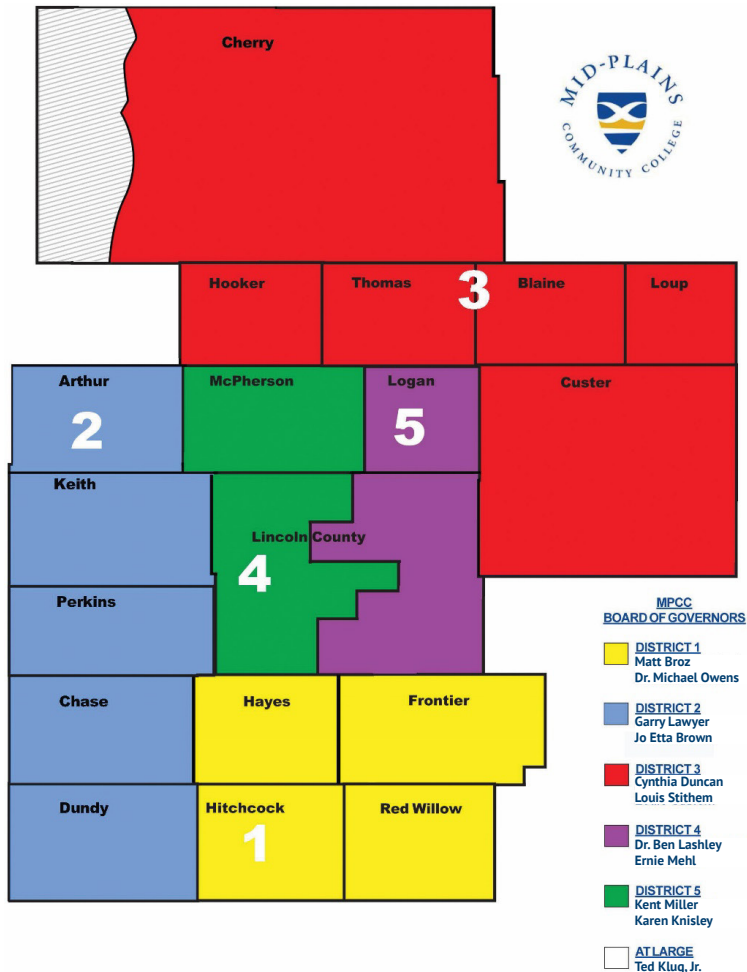
