Area Director of Accounting: The Director will provide leadership and vision for the Business Office of the College. The Director is responsible for maintaining the integrity of Business Office functions including general ledger, A/P, A/R, purchasing, payroll/benefits administration, financial statements, and annual audit preparation. The Director supervises a staff of six and maintains the general ledger module in the College's software system. The Director will also be a member of several cross-functional teams at the College.
