

IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED:

Measles (Rubeola) – One of the following is required

Lab documentation of immunity (positive antibody test)

Documentation of 2 doses of Measles or MMR vaccine

Documentation of 1 dose of Measles or MMR received after 1989

Mumps – One of the following is required

Lab documentation of immunity to mumps (positive antibody test)

Documentation of 1 dose of Mumps or MMR vaccine

Rubella (German Measles) – One of the following is required

Currently: MMR must include 2 immunizations with the 1st dose being after 12 months of age. If any of the three (Measles, Mumps, or Rubella) were diagnosed, then evidence of immunity (positive titer) must be provided for all three.

Tuberculosis Disease or Testing – One of the following is required

Documentation of tuberculin skin testing (PPD) **within the past 12 months**

Documentation of a positive tuberculin skin test including chest x-ray results and medical treatment received.

Varicella (Chicken pox) – One of the following is required

Lab documentation of immunity to varicella zoster virus (positive antibody test)

Documentation of 2 doses of Varicax (Chickenpox Vaccine)

Hepatitis B – One of the following is required

Documentation of Hepatitis B vaccinations or have initiated series of vaccines

Lab documentation of antibodies to Hepatitis B (positive antibody test)

Tetanus (Td)

Documentation of Td (the adult version of Tdap) immunization within the past 10 years

Currently: Tdap (including pertussis). There should be two years between Dt and Tdap if Dt was given in the last 2 years. No pertussis titer is allowed. Must be given immunization even with documentation of illness.

Influenza Vaccine – yearly vaccination required or documentation by medical professional as to why you are unable to receive the vaccine.
