² All MPCC Housing residents are allowed 1 lock-out with no consequence. A 2nd lock-out (1st violation) will result in a \$20 fine. A 3rd lock-out (2nd violation) will result in a \$40 fine. Each further lock-out will result in a minimum \$50 fine and 5 hours community service. Failure to complete the community service within 30 days may result in non-compliance with a college official judicial sanction.
