At the conclusion of the MPCC Associate Degree in Nursing Program, the student will be able to:

## Program Completion

The number of students who complete the program within 100% of the stated program length beginning with enrollment in the first nursing course.

- Generic students take four (4) semesters to complete.
- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)-to-ADN Option take a bridge course and three (3) semesters to complete.

Expected Level of Achievement: Sixty-five percent (65%) of students will graduate in four (4) semesters.
